What Will the Task Forces Be Doing This Year?

- Following the Milestones and Work Plan in the institutional proposal*
- Hosting outreach events (one or two all-campus events, but also meetings with various standing committees and other groups for feedback and updates*
- Practical inquiry and making useful things:*

Identify indicators of quality and improve the Annual Reports campus-wide to include and make use of them; identify gaps between campus plans and figure out how to integrate all of the plans

Make a university-wide data base for student learning outcomes; improve the PPR process to link demonstrated academic quality to resources

Identify shared views of student writing and develop all-university rubrics and student learning outcomes for writing

Identify gaps in advising practices; create professional development for the advising community; improve the TDA for use by everyone; assess student engagement; provide more information on student-faculty research projects and opportunities.
